



### Scheduled H1N1 Vaccination Clinics for SVVSD students

Free H1N1 vaccinations will be offered to St. Vrain Valley School District students at area high schools beginning October 26. The clinics will be run by the Longmont Clinic and the Boulder and Weld County Health Departments.

Only intramuscular injections will be given at these clinics, no nasal Flu Mist will be available. Children under age 10 will need to receive a second dose of the vaccine a month after the first dose to assure full immunity. A second round of clinics at the same locations will begin November 30.

Students must be accompanied by their parent or a legal guardian, with a valid ID, to receive the vaccine and families are requested to attend the clinic at the high school closest to their home. The clinics will be held from 5:00 – 8:30 PM, and the locations and dates for the first and second round of vaccinations are as follows:
